
Dear Ms. Peterson:

We have reviewed the revised supplemental drug rebate agreement (SRA) submitted by Oregon that makes technical and formatting edits. We do not consider these to be substantive changes; therefore, the State is not required to submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA). As requested by the State, we are pleased to inform you that the attached SRA is authorized, effective January 1, 2016.

We believe that the Oregon SRA continues to be consistent with the objectives of the Medicaid program. Please note that this authorization extends only to the revised SRA, amendments and exhibits that are attached to this correspondence. These revised SRA documents will replace the current SRA packet submitted to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) on December 16, 2014 and effective on January 1, 2015. If changes are subsequently made to the supplemental drug rebate agreements, amendments or exhibits, any such documents should be submitted to CMS for review and authorization.
